

# MIRACLE ACROSS THE SOUND

Inspired by the history of the Danes and their Jewish neighbors who worked together to defy the Reich, *Miracle Across the Sound* is a story of bravery, love, and true freedom. It is September 1943, and Jews are still free in German-occupied Denmark. But that is about to change.





### Synopsis:

In September of 1943, Jews in Denmark, unlike in the rest of occupied Europe, remain free. The plan to end that situation begins unfolding late one night in September when Liesel Prestur witnesses the Wassermann family getting hauled off by the Gestapo. Unable to sleep, she goes down to warm milk ... and overhears Mrs. Lund ranting next door about illegal flyers her son Flem, Liesel's ex-fiancée—whom she still loves—has been printing. Terrified that her Nazi brother, Aldur, might hear them, Liesel sneaks out the back to warn the Lunds. When the young couple's eyes meet, after not speaking for a year, old sparks flame. Impulsively, Liesel asks Flem to let her help with his flyers, nearly giving his mother a heart attack. But Flem calls her request a miracle.

Unbeknownst to his parents and his Lutheran ex-fiancée, Flem has been asking Yeshua, Israel's Messiah—the one Liesel calls Jesus—to restore their broken relationship ... and that night the Lord does. But two days later, Denmark's government dissolves. Martial law is declared. Now the young couple must delay their plans to help smuggle as many Jews as they can, including Flem's family, across the sound into neutral Sweden. Rumors are rife! At midnight, on October 1<sup>st</sup>, Rosh Hashanah, a raid on Jewish homes will begin.
